God's Pattern for Relationships

Developing Intimacy, commitment
and communication with our children

Three fundamental things we need to develop to have the relationship God wants us to have with our children.

Meaningful touch – Encourages intimacy

Old Testament Example—Genesis 27:21, 26

Jesus' Example—Mark 10:13-16: Jesus touched the children.

Our response—We communicate love and a blessing through our touch.

Spoken message, blessings for your children—Enhances communication

Speaking words of Faith over your children which paint a positive future—Hebrew 11:1

Old Testament Examples—Genesis 27:27-29

Jesus' Example—Long before Peter ever acted much like one, Jesus was calling him the rock on whom he would build the church

Our Response—Do not buy-the-lie; it has never been wrong for us to telegraph our godly expectations for our children.

Quality Time, attaching High Value to our children—Develops both intimacy and communication!

Old Testament Example—Genesis 49:9, 21, 22

Jesus' Example—John 3:22

Our Response—Our children spell love T-I-M-E
